The winner of the Chamber 50/50 Lottery was Mr.




Doug Harms winning \$1,000! The Chamber is looking at the possibility of doing another 50/50 Lottery later this year.

That's 4,800 gallons per minute that drew down the city water reserves very quickly. If that fire would have been any bigger, the city would have run out of water, thus forcing the fire department to haul water in from outside the city limits. A good example of why additional water system improvements are necessary.



Athol's Citizen of the Year: Awarded to a Youth Services Librarian, Denise Neujahr, with


