Open BID for the Water Improvement Projects were

submitted and it appears the lowest bid was NNAC. Work should be beginning mid-September. We will try and keep you posted of a schedule for which areas the work will be being done.

- We will have a <u>Public Hearing for the FY2021 Annual Appropriation Budget</u> at 6:00pm on Tuesday September 1st, 2020. Citizens are always welcome to come and ask questions or make comments.
- Possible Property Tax Relief that has come out of the Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF). The CRF was Governor Little's public safety payroll proposal. Upon further review of the finer details, Athol is not eligible for this opt-in savings option, as we do not pay for, nor have EMS, Fire or Police services. So, the City of Athol electing to not take

the 3% increase in property taxes would still not bring any savings or reduction to its citizens who pay property taxes. It is important to understood why the city did not participate, unfortunately it is just part of the conditions that were written into the policy. It is in the fine print of the grant application, and staff called both the Association of Idaho Cities and Idaho Department of Commerce, who confirmed that Athol would not be eligible. The property owners in Athol will not see these savings regardless of the percentage the city council chooses to take this year for property taxes.

The fine is <u>doubled</u> if you do not get the permit before you begin.
