

Did you know... that the City Code has restrictions for living in a Recreational Vehicle or travel trailer? Outside of an approved RV park, an RV can be occupied for <u>no more than 30 consecutive days</u> during any calendar year, in a Residential zone. And not allowed in the Commercial zone at all. Feel free to contact the City Hall or the City Planner, Rand Wichman, if you have questions on the requirements for RV's.
