✓ You have probably seen NNAC around town on 3rd St, 4th St. and Davis Lane and along Hwy 54 as they are getting ready to bore the road for new larger water lines.

NNAC has also removed the two Cemetery Water Tanks, waiting now for the new tanks to be built and brought in. They hope to continue to work until the weather starts to slow things down. If you have any questions or concerns during construction, please contact the Site Superintendent Mark Trapp at (208) 660-7190 or General Superintendent Alex Bell at (208) 660-3098. Thank you for your patience as we start the process to improve your water system.

- ✓ The Council is also planning for a City Code Amendment Update.
 A Public Hearing will be held on **November 17th at 6pm.** These proposed changes and official notice of the Public Hearing will also be available on the city website: www.cityofathol.us or from City Hall. Most of the proposed changes are general clean-up and moving the council meeting times from 7pm to 6pm, changes in planning and zoning, parade, and assembly permits, etc., but it is always good to take a look.
