City Roads and Snow Plowing

Winter is near and along with that comes snow plowing.

Just a few reminders to help make winter a happier time for all of us. Items left in the right-of-way are left there at your own risk and could be struck by a snowplow during plowing. If there is damage to a snowplow or other city equipment caused by items that have been left in the right-of-way you could be subject to reimbursing the City the cost of that damage.

Cars, trucks, boats, trailers, and other misc. items all need to be removed for plowing. When removing snow from your driveway do not snow blow or plow snow into the street.




