Did you know . . . that all structures, including so called "temporary structures" are required to meet setbacks?

The City Code does not differentiate between structures built on permanent foundations or those placed on blocks or directly on the ground. **Freestanding structures that are smaller than 200 square feet**, such as a doghouse or chicken coop, do not require a building permit, but they are required to meet setbacks.

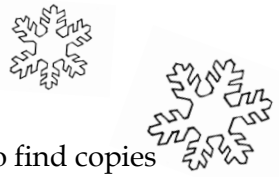
