




Come and join us for the annual Athol Christmas Market presented by the Athol Farmers Market.

<u>Water Improvements</u> – The work on the project is complete! 6.5 years from start to finish, just some paperwork left to finish the project out and get the loan payment set-up to begin making payments. While none of us like to see the increase in rates, it was appropriate and necessary to get this work done. The city is very appreciative of your community support in our efforts to make these much-needed improvements. Athol should be proud to have non-treated water, and a great running operational system bringing increased water pressures and volume. Not to mention that nearly 51% of the project was funded through grants! Saving you, the residents of the city, a couple million dollars! A reminder that the new water rates will be in effect as of the November 2022 billing.

They have cleared the lot and are just getting started on a brand-new shop/office space. <u>Rapid Diesel Performance</u> off Hwy 54 & Pastime Street and <u>Perfection Landscape</u> on Hwy 54 and Meadow Street.
