Monday, August 28, 2023 and it closes Friday, September 8, 2023 at 5:00pm.


Stop by Athol City Hall to get all the information to get signed up.


After the parade at approx. 10:15am, in the park near the skate park:


- A Dance performance from the North Idaho Sparklers
