The American Council of Engineering Companies (**ACEC**) selected Keller Associates for Athol's Water Project and received 1<sup>st</sup> place in Category G. The \$4.2 million dollar Water Project, Athol: Elevating Pressure at Low Maintenance, was in the Water

Resources category.

## Did you know .....

.... that the City Code has restrictions for living in a Recreational Vehicle or travel trailer?

Outside of an approved RV park, an RV can be occupied for no more than 30 total days during any calendar year, in a Residential zone.

And it is not allowed in the Commercial zone at all.

**Bennett Avenue Reconstruction Project:** Big Sky Corp. has been onsite, working hard on the Bennett Avenue road project. They should be done about mid-June. Bennett Avenue will be fully reconstructed, the back parking lot at City Hall will be paved with a walk path to the building, and parking on the east and west sides of the park will be asphalted. Please do not drive around the road closed signs and do not drive on the grass. Big Sky will return near the end of July to Chip Seal Menser. (Old Hwy 95 to 1st St.)

<u>Public Hearing:</u> on June 20<sup>th</sup> – There is a request for a Condition Use Permit (CUP) by Gabe & Kurryn Dippolito for a new building for Sonrise Christian Preschool and Daycare on Menser Avenue. Public testimony will be taken on this matter beginning at 6:00pm. Please plan to attend and let your city council know if you support this use or if you don't. **Hearing is being RESCHEDULED** 

<u>Yard Maintenance</u>: A friendly reminder to please pay special attention to where your water utility meters are located and try to keep the weeds and grasses clear around it. All grasses, noxious weeds (as defined in Idaho Code section 22-2402) or other weeds need to stay under ten inches (10") tall. (Ord. 271, 7-1-2008) This will also aide in fire safety and just make the city prettier. Thanks

<u>Fire Hydrants:</u> Please be sure to keep all debris free and clear, at least three feet (3') around a Hydrant. No vehicle shall be allowed to stand within eight feet of such hydrant.

<u>Water Meter:</u> Property owners are not to turn the meters on or off. You really should have a shut off after the meter on your property in case of emergencies but if you don't you can call Kevin at 208-683-1130 in case of an emergency. Even if it is after normal business hours. (Please be sure it is for water related emergencies only)


