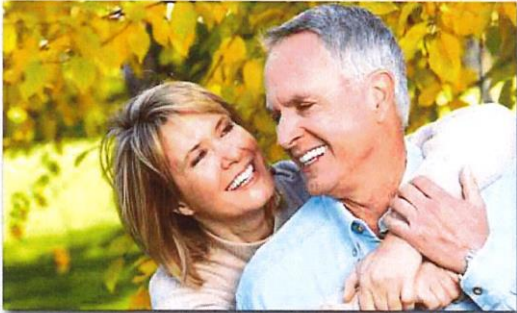
City Hall will be CLOSED

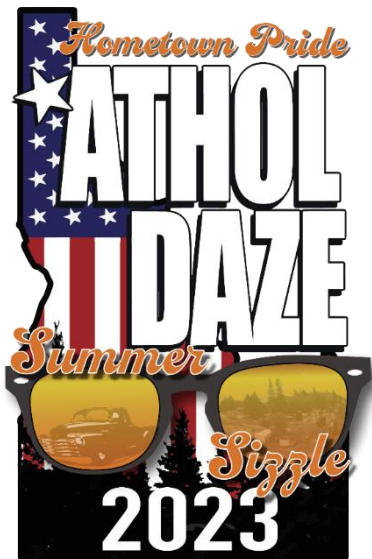
