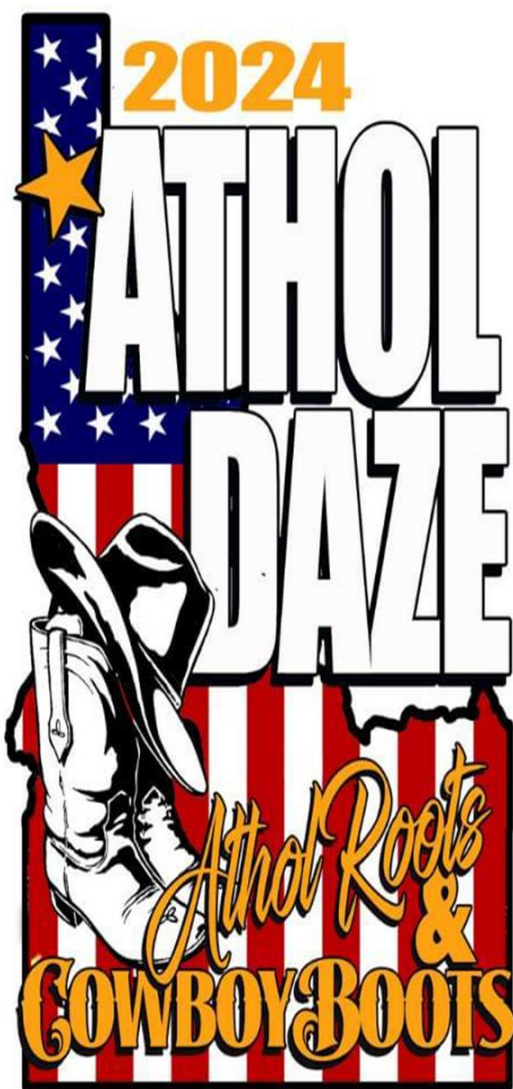

After the parade at approx. 10:15am, in the park near the skate park:

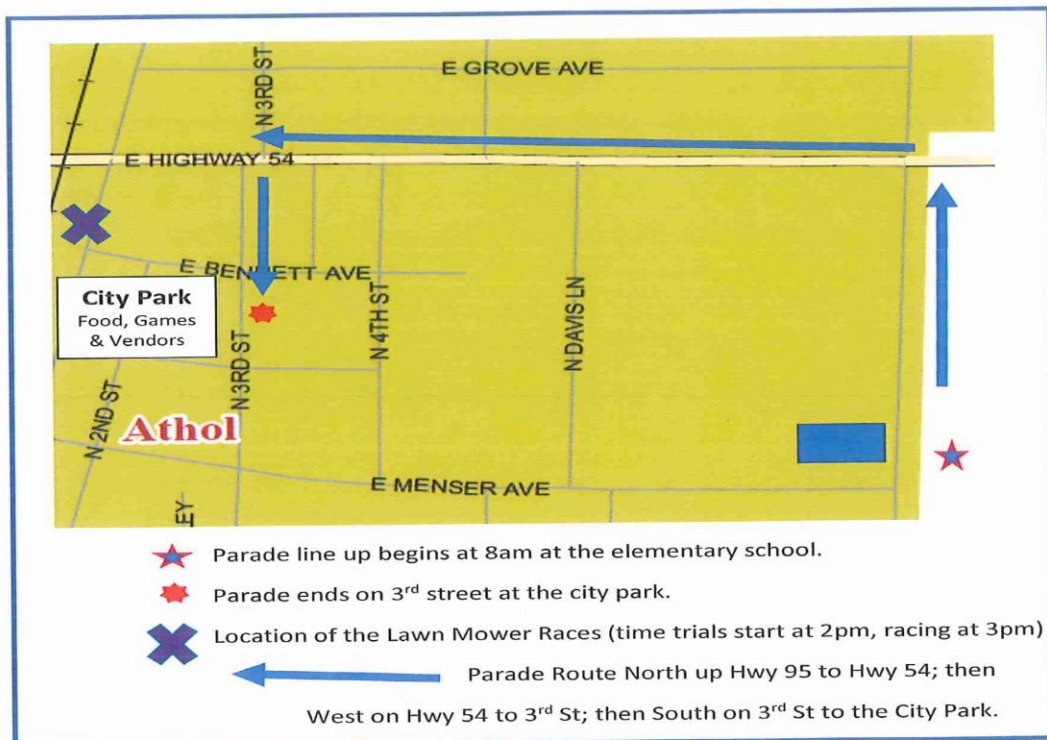
- A Demonstration performance by the Lakeland Judo Club
