

- Water Service- Please clear around your meter boxes, making them accessible for reading meters. Pete will be out soon to begin reading. Be sure the area around your water meter is clear from debris and nothing is blocking, and no vehicles parked over, leave 2 to 3 feet clear around it. We need to be able to access those boxes to read your water usage.
- Bennett Well Pump Replacement Project We replaced the pump in the Bennet Well, everything went as expected. This means the city is back running 100% with all 3 wells.


